DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

1. In the following definitions of Classes First Prize wins in Limited Show Obedience Classes and Open Shows confined to one breed do not count for entry in Open and Championship Obedience Classes.

2. A dog must be entered in the lowest scheduled class for which it is eligible and may also be entered in another 2 (3 in total) if desired, one special class excepted. Exemptions from this regulation are: - A dog entered in a Good Citizen Dog Scheme Special Pre-Beginner Obedience Stakes Class or a Young Kennel Club (YKC) Obedience Class which may also be entered in a maximum of two other scheduled classes (including YKC classes) for which it is eligible.

3. Societies may schedule classes other than those defined below. The eligibility for "Special" classes must be defined by the Society and included in the schedule. The word "Special" must be included in the title of the class.

SPECIAL ABC Anything but a collie, open to all dogs, other than a Collie, WSD, CollieX or WSDX (Intro to B). The aim is to reward attitude, commitment as well as accuracy, no scent or stays.

GOOD CITIZENS SPECIAL PRE-BEGINNERS To compete in this class a handler or dog must not have won a First Prize in either Pre-Beginners or Beginners nor gained a third place or above in any other obedience class (Introductory Class excepted).

INTRODUCTORY To compete in the Introductory Class a handler or dog must not have won one Introductory Class or have achieved a 4th place or above in Pre-Beginners or in any other class.

PRE-BEGINNERS To compete in Pre-Beginners a handler or dog must not have won a First place in either Pre-Beginners or Beginners nor gained a third place or above in any other Obedience class (Introductory Class excepted).

BEGINNERS To compete in Beginners a handler or dog must not have won a total of two or more First places in Beginners Class or one First place in any other Obedience class (Introductory Class and Pre-Beginners excepted).

NOVICE For dogs which have not won 2 First places in Obedience classes (Introductory Class, Pre-Beginners and Beginners excepted).

CLASS A For dogs which have not won 3 First Prizes in Class A, B and Open Class C in total.

CLASS B For dogs which have not won 3 First Prizes in Class B and Open Class C in total.

YKC BASIC

- Members must be aged 6 years and up to, but not including their 25th birthday and enter the age category they fall under on the date of the qualifier.

- For dogs that have not won TWO or more first prizes in a YKC Obedience class within qualifying marks or won ONE or more first prize in any standard Obedience class (Introductory Class exempt) held at a KC Licensed Open or Championship Obedience Show.

YKC NOVICE

- Members must be aged 6 years and up to, but not including their 25th birthday and enter the age category they fall under on the date of the qualifier.

- For dogs that have not won FOUR or more first prizes in a YKC Obedience class or have not won TWO or more first prizes in a standard Novice Obedience class or above held at a KC Licensed Open or Championship Obedience Show.

- First prizes in the YKC Basic Obedience Class are exempt.

- Prior to the 1st January 2017, First Prizes in the YKC Starters Obedience Class or YKC Elementary Obedience Class are also exempt.

YKC HIGH FLYERS

- Members must be aged 6 years and up to, but not including their 25th birthday and enter the age category they fall under on the date of the qualifier.

- Open to all dogs except dogs qualified to work in Championship Class C.

- Retrieve, Sendaway, Distant Control, Scent and Stays – In addition to the dog's name, one command by word or signal is permitted as in Obedience Class. Handlers will be penalised for extra commands in these exercises.

CLASS 13 SPECIAL PRE-BEGINNER KCGCDS HEAT:

Play/motivate dog, heel on lead, examination of dog, recall with finish, and control at gate.

Stay 1 minute in sight.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

These Rules & Regulations are to be read in conjunction with the Kennel Club Obedience Show Regulations G under which this show is licensed. It is the responsibility of everyone entering this show to make themselves familiar with the Kennel Club G Regulations, available from the Kennel Club.

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club licensed Obedience Shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B.
2. All dogs registered and resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
3. Only dogs six calendar months of age and over are eligible for competition at Kennel Club Licenced Obedience Shows
4. Not for competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged four calendar months and over. Dogs must be Kennel Club registered with their full details recorded on the entry form.
5. Entries may be received via With Your Dog on the Internet
6. Running orders will be available online at Obedienceuk, and will be sent by email, unless a competitor has stated they wish to receive theirs by post.
7. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries
8. In the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the club/society will refund fees less reasonably incurred expenses on receipt of a stamped addressed envelope submitted within 1 month of the show date.
10. In classes without a full running order dogs will be received until one hour after the commencement of judging (**i.e. 10.00 am**) after which no dogs may be received except under unforeseen and exceptional circumstances and by special permission of the Show Management
11. **TIMED STAYS** commence at 10.00 am and will be displayed at the show and **TAKE PRECEDENCE OVER ALL OTHER EXERCISES**
12. For the duration of the show all dogs including those in the exercise area must be on a lead except when competing or practising prior to competition.
13. Animals Allowed in Event.

No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the General Committee.

However, at the discretion of the show society, a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show, with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times.

14. A dog shall be disqualified and removed from the Show if it is: - a) A bitch which is in season. b) Suffering from any infectious or contagious disease. c) Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent. d) Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal. e) Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.

15. Dogs will be disqualified if proved to have been handled by the scheduled judge's spouse or immediate family or resident at the same address as the scheduled judge.

16. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show.

17. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the Judge or Judges

18. Should a judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.

19. Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to the Kennel Club.

20. No Prize money is on offer.

21. All offers of sponsorship or donation must be included with the name of the sponsors

22. **DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS.** Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts of travelling to and whilst at Kennel Club licensed events.

* When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.

* Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight, there should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.

* Keep the dog in the shade, Take your own shade, for example a large umbrella, and always have plenty of water available, so your dog stays well hydrated.

Remember if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and de-hydrated and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.

23. Welfare of Dogs

Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licenced event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dogs are met, and should not put a dogs health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

Right to refuse Entries Exhibitors/competitors are reminded that show societies have the right under Kennel Club Regulation to refuse any entry.
